Out of the Blue: Dual Time GMT Resonance Manufacture Edition Blue

For those who look closer.

Blue has long been part of watchmaking's vocabulary. On the *Dual Time GMT Resonance Manufacture Edition Blue*, it feels familiar – but never expected. Drawn from classical watchmaking codes, the deep blue carries a subtle **retro-chic character**, moving from the mainplate to the hands and indexes before continuing onto the dark blue alligator strap. **A classic colour, placed where Armin Strom has never taken it before.**

The blue finds its counterpoint in **two finely grained white dials with white azurage chapter rings**. Their subtle texture catches the light while allowing the **blue mainplate** underneath to come through with greater contrast. The white dials are punctuated by **blue PVD coated applied indexes and faceted hands**, picking up the colour of the mainplate beneath. **The closer the eye gets, the more the contrast reveals.**

Two Oscillators. One Resonance.

Armin Strom's manufacture calibre **ARF22** features two independent time displays governed by the **physical phenomenon** of **resonance**. Entirely **designed, developed and produced in-house**, the groundbreaking mechanism incorporates the brand's **patented resonance clutch**, enabling its **two independent regulating systems to oscillate in resonance** with one another. The continuous interaction of the two balance wheels creates a kinetic display with striking three-dimensional depth, offering a direct view of resonance at work. Each time zone features its own hours, minutes and **day/night indicator**, providing intuitive functionality for frequent travellers. Operating at **3.5 Hz (25,200 vph)** with a **42-hour power reserve**, the **ARF22** transforms the phenomenon of resonance into a functional complication.

A different kind of Blue.

Blue changes more than the colour of this calibre. It changes the way its hand-finishing reveals itself. On the dial side, the blue mainplate defines the open-worked architecture, framing the two white dials with their **finely grained finish** and **blue faceted, polished indexes**. Each dial incorporates a **black-polished day/night indicator** depicting sun rays and a crescent moon, the latter engraved with a crater-like texture.

Turning the watch over reveals the reverse of the same mainplate, featuring **relief lettering** created by **laser engraving**, together with two matching blue **gear-train bridges**. The **polished bevels** bordering the **blue PVD mainplate** and **gear-train bridges** appears brighter and more pronounced against the deep blue surfaces, catching the light with every change of angle. What is normally a subtle finishing detail becomes a defining visual feature of the movement. The **Côtes de Genève** on the **rhodium coloured barrel bridge** introduce another play of light, their linear finish contrasting with the depth of the surrounding blue. **Black-polished elements, circular graining** and **perlage** complete the traditional hand-finishing.
